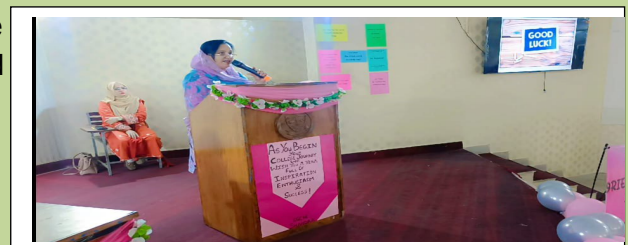
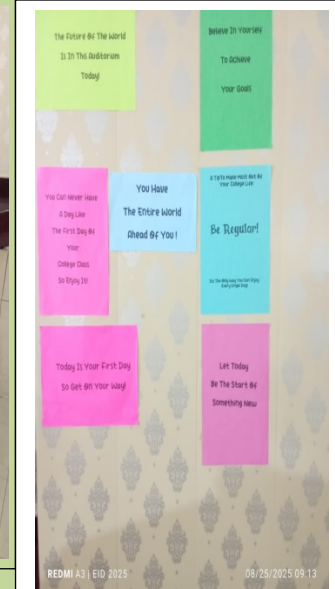
## 78<sup>th</sup> Independence Day

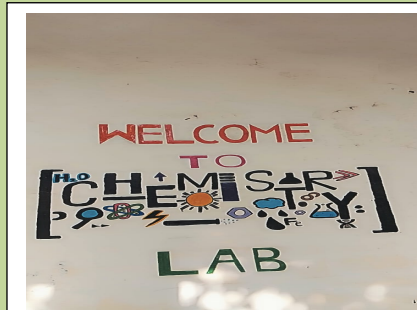
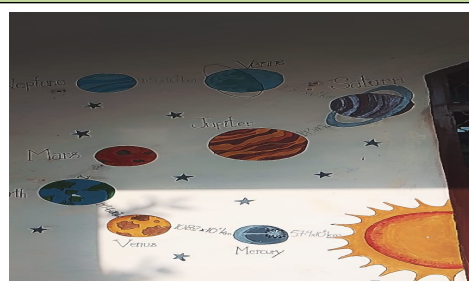
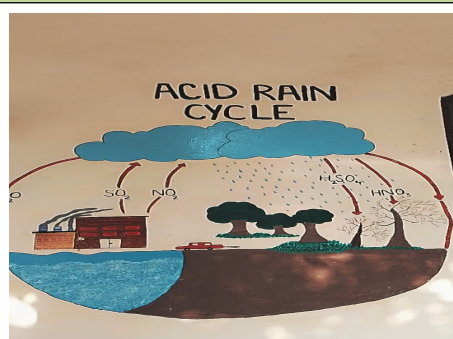
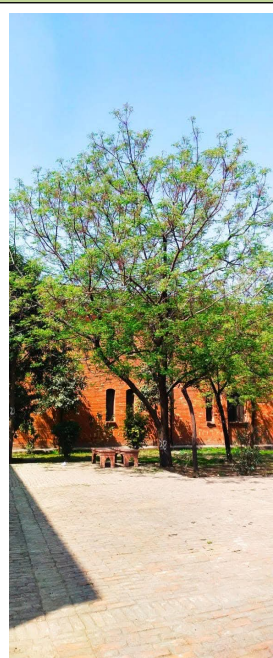
## Defense Day Observed With Patriotic Spirit

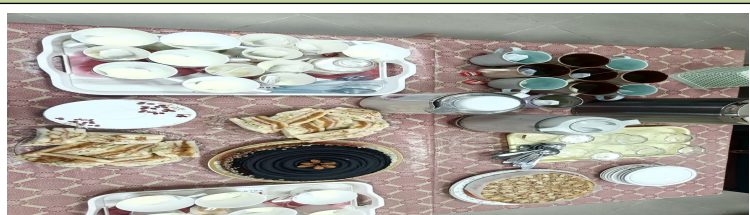
# Anti-Corruption

## Iqbal Day

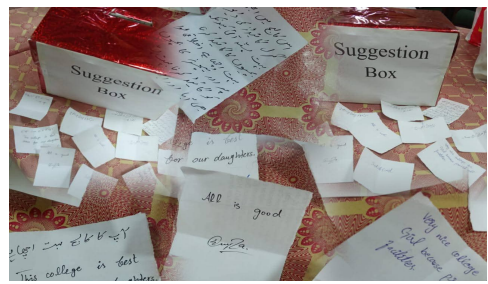
